

Operation of the Board:

- The Department shall keep the Advisory Board members periodically apprised of significant developments within the Department, and emerging opportunities. The Chair of the Department of Physics will communicate to the Board two times each year to provide updates on department activities. The updates will occur at the close of the Fall and Spring semesters. In addition, the Chair may elect to send specific updates as events warrant.
- The Physics Executive Advisory Board members shall be periodically consulted electronically to advise and assist ongoing departmental initiatives, as appropriate, consistent with the strategic directions of the Department, the College of Arts and Sciences and the University of South Florida.
- The Executive Advisory Board members shall attend an Annual Advisory Board Meeting at USF, at a time mutually convenient to the Board members and the Chair of the Department of Physics.
- The Annual Advisory Board meeting will be used to assess ongoing activities and provide direction on new initiatives in the Physics Department. These may include new educational and research initiatives, interdisciplinary interactions within the University and with external organizations, industrial outreach activities, strategies for faculty and student recruitment, curricular initiatives, and the formulation of a Master Plan for future departmental development.
