

Selection of the Board

- The Physics Executive Advisory Board shall comprise three to five members selected by the Department Chair in consultation with the faculty, and with the approval of the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. Board members shall be chosen to represent the diversity of activities within the Physics Department and to further the effectiveness of Board activities consistent with the Mission Statement.
- The Chair of the Physics Executive Advisory Board shall be appointed by the Department Chair, with the approval of the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.
- Each member of the Board shall be appointed for a three-year term, renewable upon mutual agreement between the Department and the Board member. This will ensure continuity of ongoing efforts over a reasonable time period, to allow effective planning and evaluation of the implementation of new initiatives.
- The Chair or any individual member of the Advisory Board may be removed from the Board at any time, upon determination that it is in the University's best interests to do so, with notice from the Department Chair and the approval of the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.
